



Meeting with President Trump and Prime Minister Trudeau

The White House, Washington, D.C.

February 13, 2017

At Schnitzer Steel, we have long supported the vital importance of rebuilding our nation's infrastructure, doing business with our Canadian neighbors, and promoting the role of women in the workforce. With those priorities in mind, yesterday I participated in a roundtable discussion at the White House with President Trump and Canadian Prime Minister Justin Trudeau to launch a new task force, the Canada-US Council for the Advancement of Women Entrepreneurs and Business Leaders. The roundtable was a productive opportunity to highlight matters that are important to our business.

My focus in this meeting was to explore ways in which the public and private sectors can partner to spur investment in infrastructure and create jobs. Infrastructure investment is important to the steel and metals recycling industries. Specifically, I recommended that we create a task force with members from both our countries to share best practices on public-private partnerships (P-3s), to develop a P-3 platform in the US, and to leverage the skills of the many women who are leaders in the infrastructure arena—in engineering, construction, real estate development, project management, finance and law.

I am optimistic about the impact that this Council may have—for women business leaders and entrepreneurs, for Schnitzer Steel, and for both the United States and Canada. I am pleased that we have a seat at this very important table and welcome all thoughts and ideas that you may have that could be of interest to the Council.
